Circus Skills

45 minutes | Up to 25 participants

A fun and challenging workshop that introduces the basics of circus. The workshops are fun and challenging, and introduce a range of basic circus and teamwork skills.

Suitable a wide range of ages starting with 4-6 year olds with parents/caregivers through to primary or secondary school students and even adult groups.

Storytelling and Circus
